

Dogs & Animals are not permitted at the Cairns Show! If you bring an animal with you will be denied entry. Exceptions to this: Service & Guide Dogs, or Animals approved for medical purposes (certificate/identification of approval will need to be shown to gate staff/security). Competitors competing in the Cairns Show Association Dog Show Championship will be able to enter the Dog Show/Campgrounds areas only – please enter via Quigley St.

This Show operates under the regulations set forth by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution, and rules of this Society, as well as any regulations specified within the individual sections of this Show's Schedule. In the event of any conflict between these rules and regulations, those outlined in the Schedule of this Society shall take precedence. By participating in any class outlined in this Schedule, all individuals agree to indemnify the CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION against liability for any accidents, damages, losses, or illnesses to any Exhibit, Exhibitor, or Competitor. Additionally, participants acknowledge that all Competitions are under the complete control of the CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION, whose decisions in all matters are final.

THE CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION

- 1. No Competition Entries or Membership Applications will be taken over the phone.
- 2. A Chief Steward will be assigned to each Section to represent it in all matters. Failure to adhere to lawful directions from appointed Stewards, Committee, or Staff, or engaging in verbal or physical abuse, will result in Disciplinary Action, which may include exclusion from further Competitions and/or the Cairns Showgrounds.
- 3. Judges will be appointed, and their decisions will be final. No verbal or written communication will be entertained or considered.
- 4. The organizers reserve the right to make any necessary decisions, inclusions, or changes to this Schedule, including Conditions of Entry and Special Regulations, without further notice.
- 5. By entering this Competition, exhibitors acknowledge their compliance with these Conditions.
- 6. Judges at The Cairns Show are prohibited from having any prior or during judging information beyond what is provided by the Cairns Agricultural Pastoral and Mining Association. Vice Presidents are not permitted to compete in sections under their control.

ANIMAL AND BIRD EXHIBITORS

- 1. All animal and bird exhibitors are required to sign an Exhibit Health Declaration upon delivering their entry and must adhere to the health requirements outlined in this document. Exhibit Health Declarations can be obtained from the Show Office or the website www.cairnsshow.com.au.
- 2. Owners of animals are responsible for any veterinary fees incurred. The Cairns Show will not assume responsibility for any veterinarian expenses.
- 3. Please take note of the following conditions for entry into the grounds:
 - a. Glass items are prohibited on the grounds.
 - b. All electrical leads must be appropriately tagged in accordance with relevant industrial regulations.
 - c. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

PRIZE MONEY & GST

The Prize Money listed in the Schedule does not include GST. GST will be added to the Prize Money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes. The Association will issue a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.

PRIVACY STATEMENT

HOW TO ENTER

- 1. Complete an Entry online or in person at the Cairns Show Office, or post via PO Box 811 Bungalow, QLD 4870.
- 2. Entries will not be accepted over the phone or after the closing date.
- 3. Pay for Entry Fees online, by direct deposit, or in person at the Cairns Show Office (cash accepted).
- 4. Entries must be delivered to the designated part of the Showgrounds by the due date time and date shown.

AFTER THE SHOW

- 1. Exhibits can be collected between 7pm-9pm Friday 19th July. Exhibitors must arrange with the Chief Steward to collect birds on the Saturday morning 20th July.
- 2. Prize Money can be collected between 9am and 4pm Monday to Friday 5th August to 30th August from the Show Office if your total prize money is less than \$50.
- 3. Proof of identity is required to collect Prize Money. If you are collecting prize money on behalf of someone else, a letter of authorisation from that person will be required.
- 4. All Prize Money less than \$50 not collected by 30th August, 4pm will be returned to the Cairns Show Association Funds.
- 5. Prize money of \$50 and over will be deposited to the entrant's nominated bank account after 30th August.
- 6. Results will be available from the Cairns Show website AFTER the conclusion of the Show.

SECTION 10 - POULTRY

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

- 1. Refer to the General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of schedule.
- 2. Please note conditions of entry and entry numbers.
- 3. If too many entries are received for all animals to be accommodated, entries will be returned and exhibitors asked to reduce the number of entries.
- 4. Exhibitors will be contacted to advise if entries are not accepted one week before delivery of entries.
- 5. Only birds registered on your entry form will be accepted. No changes or alterations to entry form after Entry Closing Date.
- 6. Decisions, inclusions, or changes to this Schedule including Conditions of Entry and Competition may be changed without further notice.
- 7. The Steve Raumer Pavilion will close on Wed & Thurs evenings at 9pm and on Friday at 7pm.
- 8. Entries in Any Other Variety classes will not be accepted unless the variety is distinctly stated on the Entry Form.
- 9. Where there are three or more exhibits of the one breed in Any Other Variety classes, a special class will be provided.
- 10. Poultry in single classes only are eligible for major awards.
- 11. Breeding pairs will only be allowed to compete in pairs only.
- 12. Grand Champion Bird of Show will be chosen from any Fowl single classes only.
- 13. Cockerels or pullets are birds under 12 months old.
- 14. All spurs must be smoothed off to no sharp points, otherwise bird will not be judged.
- 15. Birds showing evidence of disease or infestation will not be accepted. The Cairns Show Society Chief Poultry Steward may, at his/her discretion refuse entry of any suspect birds. Any and all birds displaying any symptoms may be referred to veterinary inspection. All birds refused entry must be removed from the Show Society premises immediately. Should you have any birds which may be suspect please refrain from bringing them to the Show Premises.
- 16. Birds found to be displaying disease or infestation during the course of the Show will not be judged but will be removed to a designated quarantine area provided by the Cairns Show Society. Owners will be notified if quarantining has occurred and must remove all such birds on the day of notification. Should either the Poultry Pavilion or quarantine area become infested as a result of diseased or infested birds the Cairns Show Society, at their discretion, will hold the Owner/s responsible for the cleaning and disinfecting of Show premises. The Cairns Show Society will take all possible care but not be held responsible for the spread of any or all infections caused by any diseased or infected birds occurring during the course of the Show.
- 17. Exhibitors must arrange with the Chief Steward to collect Poultry on Saturday 20th July.
- 18. All exhibitors must use Quigley Street entrance on exhibition days.
- 19. No free passes are available to exhibitors.
- 20. A Judge shall not have any information prior to or during judging at the Cairns Show 2024 other than what is provided by the Cairns Agricultural Pastoral and Mining Association.
- 21. Judges decision is final.
