- 2. Entries will not be accepted over the phone or after the closing date.
- 3. Pay for Entry Fees online, by direct deposit, or in person at the Cairns Show Office (cash accepted).
- 4. Entries must be delivered to the designated part of the Showgrounds by the due date time and date shown.

AFTER THE SHOW

- 1. Exhibits can be collected between 7pm-9pm Friday 19th July. Exhibitors must arrange with the Chief Steward to collect birds on the Saturday morning 20th July.
- 2. Prize Money can be collected between 9am and 4pm Monday to Friday 5th August to 30th August from the Show Office if your total prize money is less than \$50.
