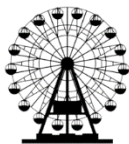

So come along, immerse yourself in the fun, and enjoy everything your local show has to offer.

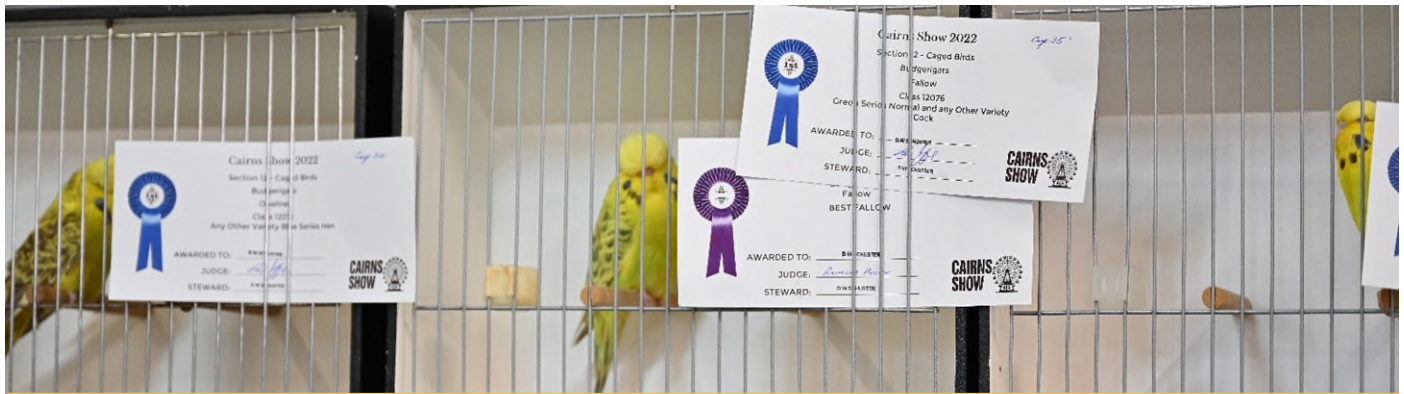

Cairns Show

Wednesday 16th, Thursday 17th, and Friday 18th July 2025

Gate Opening Times:

9am to 9pm daily - *some attractions closing times may vary.*

Cairns Show Map:

The Map is available at all Gate Entrances as well as in the Cairns Show Guide, online via the Cairns Show Website, Facebook, and Instagram pages.

Gate Entrances:

1. Corner of Severin St and Mulgrave Rd (Main Gates).
2. Quigley Street.
3. Mulgrave Rd, in front of the Fred Moule Exhibition Centre.
4. Scott Street.

Taxi Ranks:

1. Mulgrave Rd, in front of the Honey Providore Horticulture Pavilion.
2. Scott St, near St Augustine's College.
3. Corner of Mulgrave Rd and Severin St.

Bus Stops:

Sunbus Pickup and Drop Offs Points:

1. To the City – Mulgrave Road opposite the Show Ground Main Entrance
2. From the City – Mulgrave Road in front of the Cairns Youth Centre

The Show is a smoke-free environment. Smoking is only permitted in signed, designated areas. Please refer to the Cairns Show Map for Smoking areas.

Cloakroom:

Next to the Show Office, Volunteers from the FNQ Hospital Foundation will look after your items while you enjoy the Show. There is FREE sunscreen available.

Wheelchair/Trolley Hire:

Unfortunately, we do not have Wheelchair or Trolley Hire at the Cairns Show. Please come prepared and refer to the Cairns Show Map for Rest and First Aid locations.

Dogs & Animals:

Dogs & Animals are not permitted at the Cairns Show! If you bring an animal with you will be denied entry. Exceptions to this: Service & Guide Dogs, or Animals approved for medical purposes (certificate/identification of approval will need to be shown to gate staff/security). Competitors competing in the Cairns Show Association Dog Show Championship will be able to enter the Dog Show/Campgrounds areas only – please enter via Quigley St.

3. Tickets can be purchased At the Gates during the Show. Cashless payment is preferred, however, limited ATMS will be available around the grounds. Please refer to the Cairns Show Map for ATM locations.
4. Please note: a Transaction Fee Per Order will be payable to the Ticketing Merchant for all Ticket Orders online and in person.
5. By purchasing a Ticket, you agree to the Terms & Conditions outlined on our website.

PRESOLD TICKETS

You can buy discounted Presold Tickets either online at www.cairnsshow.com.au or at Earlville Shopping Town from Friday 5th to Monday 14th July, between 9am and 5pm. On Tuesday 15th July, tickets will be available at the Main Gates of the Cairns Showgrounds from 9am to 5pm, but only online purchases will be available after 5pm.

This Show operates under the regulations set forth by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution, and rules of this Society, as well as any regulations specified within the individual sections of this Show's Schedule. In the event of any conflict between these rules and regulations, those outlined in the Schedule of this Society shall take precedence. By participating in any class outlined in this Schedule, all individuals agree to indemnify the CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION against liability for any accidents, damages, losses, or illnesses to any Exhibit, Exhibitor, or Competitor. Additionally, participants acknowledge that all Competitions are under the complete control of the CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION, whose decisions in all matters are final.

THE CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION

1. No Competition Entries or Membership Applications will be taken over the phone.
2. A Chief Steward will be assigned to each Section to represent it in all matters. Failure to adhere to lawful directions from appointed Stewards, Committee, or Staff, or engaging in verbal or physical abuse, will result in Disciplinary Action, which may include exclusion from further Competitions and/or the Cairns Showgrounds.
3. Judges will be appointed, and their decisions will be final. No verbal or written communication will be entertained or considered.
4. **The organizers reserve the right to make any necessary decisions, inclusions, or changes to this Schedule, including Conditions of Entry and Special Regulations, without further notice.**
5. By entering this Competition, exhibitors acknowledge their compliance with these Conditions.
6. Judges at The Cairns Show are prohibited from having any prior or during judging information beyond what is provided by the Cairns Agricultural Pastoral and Mining Association. Vice Presidents are not permitted to compete in sections under their control.

ANIMAL AND BIRD EXHIBITORS

1. All animal and bird exhibitors are required to sign an Exhibit Health Declaration upon delivering their entry and must adhere to the health requirements outlined in this document. Exhibit Health Declarations can be obtained from the Show Office or the website www.cairnsshow.com.au.
2. Owners of animals are responsible for any veterinary fees incurred. The Cairns Show will not assume responsibility for any veterinarian expenses.
3. Please take note of the following conditions for entry into the grounds:
 - a. Glass items are prohibited on the grounds.
 - b. All electrical leads must be appropriately tagged in accordance with relevant industrial regulations.
 - c. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

PRIZE MONEY & GST

The Prize Money listed in the Schedule does not include GST. GST will be added to the Prize Money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes. The Association will issue a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.

PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Cairns Show Association uses the information you provide in Membership or entry applications to offer member services and to organize and conduct competitions at the Cairns Show. By applying for Membership or entering our competitions, you consent to provide details such as your name, address, and exhibit details. HOW TO ENTER

1. Complete an Entry online or in person at the Cairns Show Office, or post via PO Box 811 Bungalow, QLD 4870.
2. Entries will not be accepted over the phone or after the closing date.
3. Pay for Entry Fees online, by direct deposit, or in person at the Cairns Show Office (cash accepted).
4. Entries must be delivered to the designated part of the Showgrounds by the due date time and date shown.

AFTER THE SHOW

1. **Exhibits can be collected between 7am-12am Saturday 19th July.**
2. Prize Money can be collected between 9am and 4pm Monday to Friday 4th August to 29th August from the Show Office if your total prize money is less than \$50.
3. Proof of identity is required to collect Prize Money. If you are collecting prize money on behalf of someone else, a letter of authorisation from that person will be required.
4. All Prize Money less than \$50 not collected by 29th August, 4pm will be returned to the Cairns Show Association Funds.
5. Prize money of \$50 and over will be deposited to the entrant's nominated bank account after 29th August.
6. Results will be available from the [Cairns Show website](http://www.cairnsshow.com.au) AFTER the conclusion of the Show.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

1. Refer to the General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of schedule.
2. The Steve Raumer Pavilion will close on Wednesday & Thursday evenings at 9pm and on Friday at 7pm.
3. Any protected bird shown must have permits held by the exhibitor.
4. Entries in any other variety classes will not be accepted unless the variety is distinctly stated on the Entry Form.
5. Birds in single classes only eligible for major awards.
6. Breeding pairs will only be allowed to compete in pairs only.
7. Grand Champion Caged Bird of Show will be chosen from all parts of the Section.
8. **No diseased or sick birds to be exhibited.**
9. Caged Birds will be fed and watered by the Show Association.
10. **Exhibitors must arrange with the Chief Steward to collect the birds on Saturday 19th July from 7am to 12am.**
11. Each exhibit must be shown in separate cages except in Best Collection of four Varieties of Finches.
12. The Cairns Show Association reserves the right if only one bird in class to move to next class.
13. Caged birds' exhibits will not be accepted unless bird cage is clean.
14. Exhibitors must supply own cage.
15. Regulation size cages are as follows:
 - Budgies to be shown in any standard show cage.
 - Canaries to be shown in any wire or box type show cage.
 - Finches to be shown in show cages no larger than 300mm x 300mm x 150mm
 - Quarrian to be shown in cages no larger than 425mm x 425mm x 210mm
 - Lovebirds to be shown in any standard budgie show cage.
16. Junior section any reasonable cage accepted.
17. Class cards must be placed in the bottom right-hand corner of cage.
18. All exhibitors must use Quigley Street entrance on exhibition days.
19. No free passes are available to exhibitors.

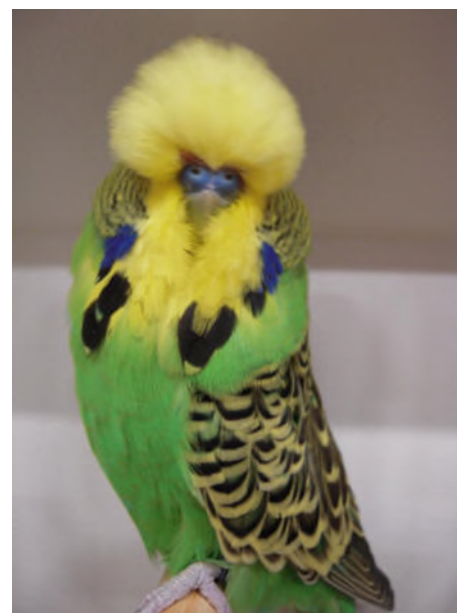

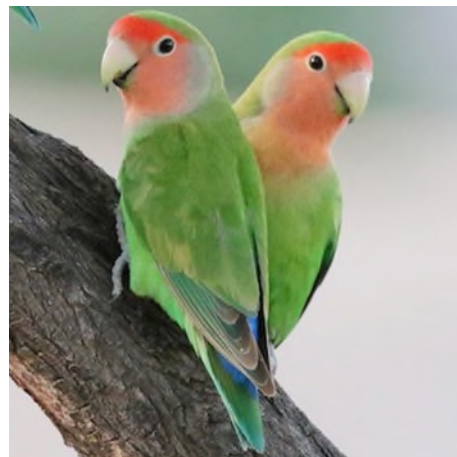

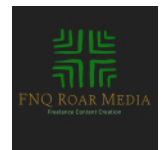
