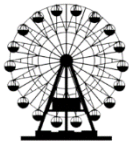

Dogs & Animals:

Dogs & Animals are not permitted at the Cairns Show! If you bring an animal with you will be denied entry. Exceptions to this: Service & Guide Dogs, or Animals approved for medical purposes (certificate/identification of approval will need to be shown to gate staff/security). Competitors competing in the Cairns Show Association Dog Show Championship will be able to enter the Dog Show/Campgrounds areas only – please enter via Quigley St.

ENTRY & COMPETITIONS

This Show operates under the regulations set forth by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution, and rules of this Society, as well as any regulations specified within the individual sections of this Show's Schedule. In the event of any conflict between these rules and regulations, those outlined in the Schedule of this Society shall take precedence. By participating in any class outlined in this Schedule, all individuals agree to indemnify the CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION against liability for any accidents, damages, losses, or illnesses to any Exhibit, Exhibitor, or Competitor. Additionally, participants acknowledge that all Competitions are under the complete control of the CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION, whose decisions in all matters are final.

THE CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION

1. No Competition Entries or Membership Applications will be taken over the phone.
2. A Chief Steward will be assigned to each Section to represent it in all matters. Failure to adhere to lawful directions from appointed Stewards, Committee, or Staff, or engaging in verbal or physical abuse, will result in Disciplinary Action, which may include exclusion from further Competitions and/or the Cairns Showgrounds.
3. Judges will be appointed, and their decisions will be final. No verbal or written communication will be entertained or considered.
4. **The organizers reserve the right to make any necessary decisions, inclusions, or changes to this Schedule, including Conditions of Entry and Special Regulations, without further notice.**
5. By entering this Competition, exhibitors acknowledge their compliance with these Conditions.
6. Judges at The Cairns Show are prohibited from having any prior or during judging information beyond what is provided by the Cairns Agricultural Pastoral and Mining Association. Vice Presidents are not permitted to compete in sections under their control.

ANIMAL AND BIRD EXHIBITORS

1. All animal and bird exhibitors are required to sign an Exhibit Health Declaration upon delivering their entry and must adhere to the health requirements outlined in this document. Exhibit Health Declarations can be obtained from the Show Office or the website www.cairnsshow.com.au.
2. Owners of animals are responsible for any veterinary fees incurred. The Cairns Show will not assume responsibility for any veterinarian expenses.
3. Please take note of the following conditions for entry into the grounds:
 - a. Glass items are prohibited on the grounds.
 - b. All electrical leads must be appropriately tagged in accordance with relevant industrial regulations.
 - c. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

PRIZE MONEY & GST

The Prize Money listed in the Schedule does not include GST. GST will be added to the Prize Money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes. The Association will issue a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.

PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Cairns Show Association uses the information you provide in Membership or entry applications to offer member services and to organize and conduct competitions at the Cairns Show. By applying for Membership or entering our competitions, you consent to provide details such as your name, address, and exhibit details. HOW TO ENTER

1. Complete an Entry online or in person at the Cairns Show Office, or post via PO Box 811 Bungalow, QLD 4870.
2. Entries will not be accepted over the phone or after the closing date.
3. Pay for Entry Fees online, by direct deposit, or in person at the Cairns Show Office (cash accepted).
4. Entries must be delivered to the designated part of the Showgrounds by the due date time and date shown.
5. Results will be available from the [Cairns Show website](#) AFTER the conclusion of the Show.

CAMPING

A Camping area has been made available behind the Goat Pavilion for exhibitors in the Goat, Bird and Dog Sections. Camping must be applied for in writing (on the Camping Form) by Friday 5th July. If approved, a camping permit will be issued which must be displayed at all times. Any camp site without a valid permit will be removed from the Showgrounds. The camping area will be patrolled by Security Guards over the period of the Show. Only those vehicles approved and used for bona fide camping purposes will be permitted to remain within the Showgrounds. The decision of the Camp Steward is final.

CONDITIONS OF SHOWING

1. Stud classes open to registered full blood and purebred animals only.
2. Age of commercial does to be determined by teeth. Judges will inspect teeth prior to judging to confirm correct classes.
3. Age will always be given to the younger class if full mouth for age is not present.
4. Age Definitions:
5. Milk Tooth = No permanent teeth cut 2 Tooth = 1 or 2 permanent teeth
6. 4 Tooth = 3 or 4 permanent teeth 6 Tooth = 5 or more permanent teeth
7. Crossbred bucks are not permitted to be shown.
8. In the commercial classes if numbers are not enough to follow the proposed classes, then the classes can be amalgamated to milk tooth, 2-4 tooth and >4 tooth animals.
9. No bucks over 6 months old will be shown in potential carcass classes.
10. Fullblood Commercial entries cannot be Stud registered. Must be registered as commercial or unregistered.
11. Capretto - no older than milk tooth
12. Chevon - no older than 2 tooth
13. Capra - no older than 4 tooth

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

1. Refer General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of schedule.
2. All livestock must remain on the Cairns Showgrounds for the three days and nights of the Annual Cairns Show. Please consider the above before lodging your entry. Cairns Show is Queensland's biggest non-Metropolitan Show for the benefit of a mainly urban clientele. Please do not regard it as a ribbons and trophy - winning exercise only.
3. All animals are to be correctly tattooed. Random tattoo checks will be conducted.
4. Age to be actual age at date of Show.
5. All full blood and purebred animals must be registered with the Boer Goat Breeders Association of Australia and Boer Goats Australia.
6. Johne's Disease goats must not be introduced unless the following are met:
7. They are from a non-restricted herd or from a Johne's Disease-free zone. Queensland is a protected zone
8. They are from a monitored negative (MN) or tested negative (TN) status herd established under an officially recognised market assurance program (MAP).
9. They are introduced from a non-assessed herd (NA) and the goats have been subjected to an AGID test, resulting in a clean test within 30 days prior to introduction, for kids less than 12 months a test on the dam is sufficient.
10. This section is open to untested animals as well as CAE/CRV tested negative individual animals and from animals from tested-free herds. All due care will be taken to provide segregation of untested animals in pens and during judging.
11. Red breeds will be shown together in their own classes and not with the Standard Boers except for group classes which will be combined
12. All animals must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor for the 3 months prior to showing.
13. All animals entered in-group classes must be entered in individual classes.
14. Animals may be checked for registration on arrival at the Show.
15. Substitute animals may be entered at the discretion of the Chief Steward
16. The use of hormones and/or tranquilisers and/or any other stimulants is strictly prohibited.
17. Random testing of animals can occur at any Show and if an exhibitor is found to be in breach of the condition of entry, they will be reported to the Federal body of BGBAA.
18. An animal entered for exhibition shall be presented in the judging ring in its natural conformation and with normal Show preparation. Any animal found to have undergone any operation or procedure materially changed by exaggeration or minimization of any body part will be disallowed

from showing that animal. The exhibitor shall be reported to the Federal board for any further action.

19. A completed entry form together with entry fee must be forwarded to the Cairns Show Association before the closing date. No late entries will be accepted.
20. A fully completed Waybill as prescribed under the Stock Act must accompany all goats.
21. **As per Biosecurity Act 2014, all kids born after 1 January 2025 must be fitted with an approved accredited electronic identification (eID) device before leaving the property of birth. Once fitted, a tag must remain on the animal for life. If a tag is removed or falls off, it must be replaced with a pink 'post-breeder' tag.**
22. All goats must be ear tagged in accordance with current NLIS regulations. DPI will check tagging. Any animal born at Cairns Show will be tagged with a Cairns Show goat ear tag before leaving the showgrounds.
23. All animals coming from tick-restricted areas must have relevant stock clearances. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to arrange for return permits and spraying of animals.
24. Any animals that in the opinion of the Stewards are not fit to be shown will not be permitted to compete.
25. Exhibitors will wear white coats while showing. At Royal Shows and large regional shows exhibitors must have coats.
26. Exhibitors should not have their stud's name on any apparel when in the judging ring.
27. No stud signs are to be erected at the Cairns Show until the judging is completed.
28. All exhibitors should be aware of, and comply with, Cairns Show ring protocols, including neat appropriate dress and covered shoes.
29. Grand Parade - All exhibitors are asked to take part and parade their stock in the Grand Parade where possible.
30. Exhibitor's passes will be issued on receipt of entry form. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to collect passes. **1 goat - 1 pass, 2 or 3 goats - 2 passes, 4 or more goats - 3 passes**

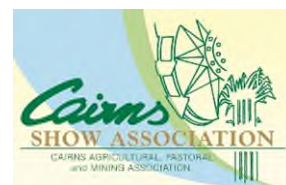
