ENTRY & COMPETITIONS

This Show operates in accordance with the regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the Constitution and Rules of the Cairns Agricultural, Pastoral and Mining Association (CAPMA), and the regulations outlined within each section of this Show Schedule. In the event of any inconsistency, the rules and regulations contained within this Society's Schedule will take precedence.

By participating in any class within this Schedule, all exhibitors and competitors agree to indemnify the Cairns Agricultural, Pastoral and Mining Association against any liability for accidents, damage, loss, or illness involving any exhibit, exhibitor, or competitor. All competitions are conducted under the full authority of CAPMA, and all decisions made by the Association are final.

THE CAIRNS AGRICULTURAL PASTORAL AND MINING ASSOCIATION

1. Competition entries and membership applications will not be accepted over the phone.
2. Each Section will have an appointed Chief Steward responsible for representing that Section in all matters. Failure to follow lawful directions from Stewards, Committee Members, or Staff, or any form of verbal or physical abuse, may result in disciplinary action, including exclusion from competitions and/or removal from the Cairns Showgrounds.
3. Judges will be appointed, and all judging decisions are final. No correspondence, verbal or written, will be entered.
4. **The Association reserves the right to make decisions, additions, or amendments to this Schedule, including Conditions of Entry and Special Regulations, without notice.**
5. By entering any competition, exhibitors acknowledge and agree to comply with all Conditions of Entry.
6. Judges must not have access to any information beyond that provided by CAPMA. Vice Presidents are not permitted to compete in sections under their direct control.

ANIMAL AND BIRD EXHIBITORS

1. All animal and bird exhibitors must complete an Exhibit Health Declaration upon delivery of their entry and comply with all health requirements outlined in the declaration. Forms are available from the Show Office or at www.cairnsshow.com.au.
2. Animal owners are responsible for all veterinary costs incurred. The Cairns Show will not cover veterinary expenses.
3. Entry to the grounds is subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Glass items are prohibited on the grounds.
 - b. All electrical leads must be tested and tagged in accordance with relevant industrial regulations.
 - c. Dogs must be always kept on a leash.

PRIZE MONEY & GST

Prize money listed in the Schedule is exclusive of GST. GST will be added for exhibitors registered for GST purposes. The Association will issue a Recipient Created Tax Invoice to eligible exhibitors.

PRIVACY STATEMENT

HOW TO ENTER

1. Complete an Entry online or in person at the Cairns Show Office, or post via PO Box 811 Bungalow, QLD 4870.
2. Entries will not be accepted over the phone or after the closing date.
3. Pay for Entry Fees online, by direct deposit, or in person at the Cairns Show Office (cash accepted).
4. Entries must be delivered to the designated part of the Showgrounds by the due date time and date shown.

AFTER THE SHOW

- Exhibits can be collected on **Saturday morning 18th July**.
- Prize Money can be collected between 9am and 4pm from Monday to Friday **3rd August to 27th August** from the Show Office if your total prize money is less than \$50.
- Proof of identity is required to collect Prize Money. If you are collecting prize money on behalf of someone else, a letter of authorisation from that person will be required.
- All Prize Money is less than \$50 not collected by **27th August**, 4pm will be returned to the Cairns Show Association Funds.
- Prize money of \$50 and over will be deposited to the entrant's nominated bank account after **27th August**.
- Results will be available from the [Cairns Show website](#) AFTER the conclusion of the Show.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

- Refer to the General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of schedule.
- Please note conditions of entry and entry numbers.
- If too many entries are received for all animals to be accommodated, entries will be returned, and exhibitors are asked to reduce the number of entries.
- Exhibitors will be contacted to advise if entries are not accepted one week before delivery of entries.
- Only birds registered on your entry form will be accepted. No changes or alterations to entry form after Entry Closing Date.
- Decisions, including inclusions or changes to this Schedule including Conditions of Entry and Competition, may be changed without further notice.
- The Steve Raumer Pavilion will close on Wednesday & Thursday evenings at 9pm and on Friday at 7pm.
- Entries in Any Other Variety classes will not be accepted unless the variety is distinctly stated on the Entry Form.
- Where there are three or more exhibits of the one breed in Any Other Variety classes, a special class will be provided.
- Poultry in single classes only are eligible for major awards.
- Breeding pairs will only be allowed to compete in pairs only.
- Grand Champion Bird of Show will be chosen from any Fowl single classes only.
- Cockerels or pullets are birds under 12 months old.
- All spurs must be smoothed off to no sharp points, otherwise bird will not be judged.
- **Birds showing evidence of disease or infestation will not be accepted.** The Cairns Show Society Chief Poultry Steward may, to his/her discretion, refuse entry of any suspected birds. All birds displaying any symptoms may be referred to veterinary inspection. All birds refused entry must be removed from the Show Society premises immediately. Should you have any birds which may be suspected please refrain from bringing them to the Show Premises.
- **Birds found to be displaying disease or infestation during the Show** will not be judged but will be removed to a designated quarantine area provided by the Cairns Show Society. Owners will be notified if quarantining has occurred and must remove all such birds on the day of notification. Should either the Poultry Pavilion or quarantine area become infested because of diseased or infested birds the Cairns Show Society, at their discretion, will hold the Owner/s responsible for the cleaning and disinfecting of Show premises. The Cairns Show Society will take all possible care but not be held responsible for the spread of any or all infections caused by any diseased or infected birds occurring during the Show.
- Exhibitors must arrange with the Chief Steward to collect Poultry on **Saturday 18th July**
- All exhibitors must use Quigley Street entrance on exhibition days.
- No free passes are available to exhibitors.
- A Judge shall not have any information prior to or during judging at the Cairns Show **2026** other than what is provided by the Cairns Agricultural Pastoral and Mining Association.
- Judge's decision is final.

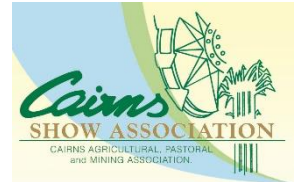

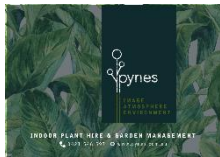
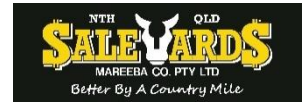
